RESIDENTIAL AND SPORTS VILLAGE:



THE SOCCER PROGRAM:

It will take place at Valdebebas, City of Footbal R.MADRID.

The complex is situated in a very special place and is one of the most promising areas for the future of the city of Madrid, the Valdebebas Park, the largest urban development project in the history of the Community of Madrid and one of the green areas that will help the city to breathe in the future. It covers approximately 2,636 acres of land and is a short distance from the Madrid-Barajas Airport.

Held by highly qualified trainers from the Real Madrid Foundation Campus Experience (during training sessions, participants will practice the basic aspects of soccer: individual and group technique. Tactic: strategy. Types of soccer kicks: push kick, outside kick, instep kick, long pass, header. Ball control: inside, outside, with sole, chest, thigh, head and feet. Ball mastery exercises with both legs. Ball handling. Shoots to goal. Combination plays: passes, crosses and shoots. Wall passes and shoots to goal. Dribble (with or without feints) and shoots to goal.

ACTIVITIES, EXCURSIONS AND SPANISH LESSONS

In Madrid Soccer Camp, we offer our students a great variety of afternoon and night activities, sports and cultural visits, all supervised and coordinated by specialized staff. We include the following excursions and activities:

- Madrid City Tour, visit the most important monuments and streets of Madrid.
- Visit to the Prado Museum: is the main Spanish national art museum, located in central Madrid. It features one of the world's finest collections of European art, dating from the 12th century to the early 20th century, based on the former Spanish Royal Collection, and unquestionably the best single collection of Spanish art. Founded as a museum of paintings and sculpture in 1819, it also contains

important collections of other types of works. El Prado is one of the most visited sites in the world, and it is considered one of the greatest art museums in the world.

- Santiago Bernabéu Stadium Tour:
 Santiago Bernabéu is one of the most spectacular stadium in the world and most prestigious football venues. It has hosted the European Cup final on four occasions: in 1957, 1969, 1980, the UEFA Champions League Final in 2010. The final matches for the 1964 European Nations' Cup and the 1982 FIFA World Cup were also held at the Bernabéu.
- Visit to Palacio Real: is the official residence of the Spanish Royal Family at the city of Madrid, but it is only used for state ceremonies. King Felipe VI and the Royal Family do not reside in the palace, choosing instead the more modest Palacio de la Zarzuela on the outskirts of Madrid.
- Shopping at Gran Vía.
- Retiro Park: This green lung in the centre of Madrid boasts several









places of interest, such as the lake, the Glass Palace and the fountain of the Fallen Angel. Games.

• Historic City of Toledo: Toledo is known as the "Imperial City" for having been the main venue of the court of Charles V, Holy Roman Emperor, and as the "City of the Three Cultures", having been influenced by a historical co-existence of Christians, Muslims and Jews. Toledo has a history in the production of bladed weapons, which are now popular souvenirs of the city.

 Amusement Park- Parque de Atracciones: is a 20-hectare (49acre) amusement park located in the Casa de Campo in Madrid, Spain. Opened in 1969, it is the third-oldest operating amusement park in Spain after the Parque de Atracciones del Tibidabo (opened in 1901) and the Parque de Atracciones Monte Igueldo (opened in 1911). It is the flagship park of Parques Reunidos, who operates the park under Madrid municipal government concession till year 2039.

• Historic City of Segovia: The city is famous for its historic buildings including three main landmarks: its midtown Roman aqueduct, its cathedral (one of the last ones to be built in Europe following a Gothic style), and the medieval castle, which served as inspiration for Walt Disney's Cinderella Castle. The city center was declared a World Heritage Site by UNESCO in 1985.

SPANISH COURSE:

The students will have 11 classes of Spanish lessons, each class lasts 55 minutes. Reading, writing, speaking and understanding are the skills our students develop in the classroom.

Also they will learn the most typical football expressions and Spanish words during the course.
